Pauline Clark Award

The Pauline Clark was the one time editor of the Ludlow Advertiser and the Award was set up in her memory.

The Award is managed by the Trustees of local Youth based charity — South Shropshire Youth Forum, who usually meet about once a month when they will consider new applications for the Award.

The Award is a small amount of money set aside to be used applied for by and to help the young people (aged 16-25) in South Shropshire to move on.

Applicants preferred are those that need help towards costs of training or qualifications who normally can't afford them. In the past we have helped young people to pay towards the costs of books for College, with transport and travel costs to work and specialist equipment required for training or for employment. All payments are made on a one-off basis, we don't have the funds to pay for ongoing costs.
